B. From the perspective of Jesus - to provide eternal, heavenly benefits (11:11)

1. Jesus was coming as conqueror of sin and death for all who believe in Him. (Ephesians 2:1-10)
2. Jesus was coming to secure peace with God for all who believe in Him. (Romans 5:1-5)
